Entry Fee: \$20/Run | Pit Pass: \$15

Helmets & Seatbelts Required for All Classes

Registration: 5:00pm | Racing: 7:00pm

General Rules

Absolutely **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** are permitted at the event. Any driver under the influence will be disqualified. Crew members are permitted in the pit area only! Only drivers are permitted on the track area for safety reasons. Drivers can be disqualified for any violation of these rules.

ABSOLUTELY NO personal vehicles allowed in the pit area! ONLY MUD BUGGY AND TOW TRUCK.
HANDICAPPED PARKING ONLY FOR THOSE WITH VALID HANDICAP PERMITS! ALL OTHERS MUST PARK IN LOWER PARKING OR FIELD.

HELMETS AND SEATBELTS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL CLASSES.

DRIVERS RULES:

1. All Drivers Must Attend Drivers Meeting
2. One Win Per Truck Class (May Have More Than One Driver but Same Driver Cannot Run More Than Twice.)
3. Must Wear Seatbelt & Helmet
4. All Trucks Must Have Tow Hook
5. No Refunds!!!
6. No One Under 16-Year-Old Will Be Allowed to Run Due to Insurance Reasons!
7. Insurance Must Be Provided by The Driver and Presented.
8. Consent And Waiver Must Be Given and Signed by Legal Guardian.
9. No Cut Tires, Except in Outlaw Class
10. We Reserve the Right to Pull a Vacuum at Any Time
11. You Have 5 Minutes to Get to The Starting Line
12. Any Driver Under the Influence Will Be Disqualified
13. Any Complaints Will Be Discussed with Track Officials. His Or Her Decision Will Be Final.
14. No Restarts Over 5'
15. All Drivers Are Subject to A 5 Minute Downtime
16. Any Fuel Tank Not Factory Must Be Strapped Down
17. If Driver Goes Out of Bounds, They Are Disqualified.
18. In The Event of a Tie, There Will Be a Tiebreaker.
19. You May Move Up a Class, But Not Down a Class.
20. All Rules Are Final.
21. Must Take Cable with You, If Not You Get Out and Hook Up.
22. Trucks That Do Not Make It Through Pit Will Be Measured in Length and Pulled Out Backwards.
23. Trucks Making It Through Pit Will Be Timed by Laser Timing.
24. Drivers Are Not to Trade Numbers or Drivers After Registration. Once A Number and Name Is Registered to A Vehicle, It Cannot Be Changed!
25. Whoever Is Inspecting the Vehicles Will Give the Drivers A Card with the Class and Signed by the Inspector.
26. Drivers Are to Pay Attention to The Announcer Booth to Get in The Vehicles and Line Up Three at A Time and Ready to Run.

Monongalia County Fair Mud Bog Rules - Continued

STREET CLASS:

1. Everything Stock
2. One Carburetor, Pump Gas Only, Or Factory Fuel Injection
3. Tires Up To 35" Dot Approved
4. No Vacuum Pumps
5. Must Appear and Sound Stock to Run
6. No License or Inspection Required
7. No More Than 6' Lift Kit
8. No Open Headers
9. No Traction Bars
10. No Cuts or Paddle Tires

MODIFIED CLASS:

1. Engine Modifications Permitted
2. Naturally Aspirated Engines Only, No Additions
3. No Nitrous Bottles
4. Ladder Bars And 4 Link Allowed
5. No Paddle or Cut Tires
6. No Major Body Modifications
7. Tires Up To 40" Dot Approved
8. Can Be Fuel Injected
9. Any OEM Production Frame

SUPERMODIFIED CLASS:

1. Tires Up To 44" DOT Approved
2. No Paddle or Cut Tires
3. No Nitrous Allowed
4. Alcohol Permitted

OUTLAW CLASS:

1. Drivers Must Wear a Helmet
2. Alcohol, Nitrous Allowed
3. Must Wear Shoulder Harness
4. Must Have Roll Cage
5. Tube Chassis Allowed
6. Up To 44" Cut and Scooper Tires
7. No Tractor Tires

All drivers must follow and obey all rules and regulations pertaining to their class. All payouts will be made after the completion of the race.

NOT GOING BY TIRE SIZE THIS YEAR

The officials have the final say on any truck in any class. The officers of Volunteer Fire Department or persons running the show have the right to deny or disqualify any vehicles not within the rules and regulations set forth above. Helmets & seatbelts must be worn at all times. If any driver arrives after the drivers meeting the will not be permitted to run.
