



Monongalia County Fair 4H & FFA Livestock Show & Auction

Market Rabbit

1. Market rabbits must be between 10-12 weeks of age at the time of weigh-in at the Monongalia County Fair.
2. Exhibitor must own doe and buck by March 1st of the current year, breed, and raise market rabbit litter pen at exhibitor's home.
3. Breed date will be no later than **May 17, 2020** with birth date of no later than **May 31, 2020** for the Monongalia County Fair.
4. Exhibitor must exhibit the buck and/or doe at the Monongalia County Fair.
5. Three rabbits will make up market rabbit pen. Market rabbit pen will be auctioned as a set of three.
6. Market rabbits will be identified by a tattoo in the left ear.
7. Each rabbit in market pen must have **minimum weight of 3 lbs.**

Market Poultry - Chicken

1. Market chicken must be between 6-10 weeks of age at the time of weigh-in at the Monongalia County Fair.
2. Purchase market chickens between **May 31, 2020** to **June 28, 2020** for the Monongalia County Fair.
3. Three poultry will make up market poultry pen.
4. Market poultry pen will be auctioned as a set of three.
5. Market poultry will be identified by a numbered leg band.
6. Each chicken in market pen must have **minimum weight of 5 lbs.**

Market Poultry - Turkey

1. Market turkey must be between 24 weeks of age at the time of weigh-in at the Monongalia County Fair.
2. Purchase market turkey **February 23, 2020** for the Monongalia County Fair
3. Market turkey will be identified by a numbered leg band.
4. Market turkey must have **minimum weight of 20 pounds.** Average Hen to gain 1 pound per week and Tom to gain 2 pounds per week.

Feeder Steer

1. Feeder steer are to be born **after January 1st** of the current year and of a beef breed.
2. Feeder steer must be castrated and dehorned prior to entrance at Monongalia County Fair
3. Feeder steer that are unkempt must be cleaned prior to weigh-in.
4. Feeder steer **minimum weight is 300 pounds**

Feeder Heifer

1. Feeder heifer are to be born **after January 1st** of the current year and of a beef breed.
2. Feeder heifer must be dehorned prior to entrance at Monongalia County Fair
3. Feeder heifer that are unkempt must be cleaned prior to weigh-in.
4. Feeder heifer **minimum weight is 300 pounds**

All animals must be vaccinated according to the West Virginia State Code, consult local veterinarian for recommendations based on your animal species.

All animals must be fed and watered from time of arrival to time of departure which includes Sunday morning.
All livestock must have a sound halter (rope) on animals after auction.

Market Steer/Market Heifer (market project)

1. Market steer/heifer are to be born **after January 1st** of the prior year and beef breed.
2. Market steer must be castrated, and market steer and heifer must be dehorned prior to entrance at Monongalia County Fair
3. Market steer/heifer that are unkempt must be cleaned prior to weigh-in.
4. Market steer/heifer **minimum weight is 1000 pounds**

Yearling Heifer (breeding project)

1. Yearling heifer are to be born **after January 1st** of the prior year and beef breed.
2. Yearling heifer must be dehorned prior to entrance at Monongalia County Fair.
3. Yearling heifer that are unkempt must be cleaned prior to weigh-in.
4. Yearling heifer **minimum weight is 700 pounds**
5. Yearling heifer are breeding project and will not be auctioned.

Market Lamb

1. Market lamb are to be born **after January 1st** of current year.
2. Market Lamb must be castrated, sheared, and dehorned prior to arrival at the Monongalia County Fair.
3. Market lamb that are unkempt must be cleaned prior to weigh-in.
4. Market lamb must have scrapie tag in place prior to entrance at Monongalia County Fair.
5. No lamb with evidence of rectal prolapse will be permitted at the Monongalia County Fair.
6. Market lamb **minimum weight is 95 pounds**

Market Goat

1. Market goat are to be born **after December 1st** of prior year.
2. Market goat are to be meat bred animals, castrated, sheared with horns tipped and covered prior to arrival at the Monongalia County Fair if applicable.
3. Market goat must have a scrapie tag in place prior to entrance at Monongalia County Fair.
4. Market goat that are unkempt must be cleaned prior to weigh-in.
5. Market goat **minimum weight is 60 pounds**

Market Hog

1. Market hog are to be born **after January 1st** of current year.
2. Market hog must be castrated prior to entrance at Monongalia County Fair.
3. Market hog that are unkempt must be cleaned prior to weigh-in.
4. Market hog **minimum weight is 225 pounds**

All animals must be vaccinated according to the West Virginia State Code, consult local veterinarian for recommendations based on your animal species.

All animals must be fed and watered from time of arrival to time of departure which includes Sunday morning.

All livestock must have a sound halter (rope) on animals after auction.
